“1) Relative to COVID-19 decisions for vaccination and masking in our facility, based on just the following choices, what do you think is the most important for us to base our decisions on?”


What the majority of other new thought/progressive churches (Unity, CSL, Unitarian) in our geographical footprint are doing.


Question 2 has 71 answers (Radio Buttons)


I am vaccinated, boosted, and wear masks in public.

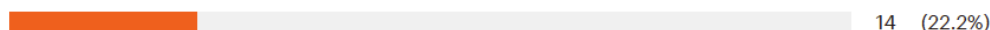
Question 3 has 63 answers (Radio Buttons)

for my own safety.



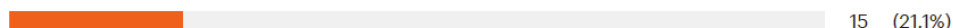
for the safety of those in my household should I contract COVID-19, because I have others in my household who are in a high-risk category.



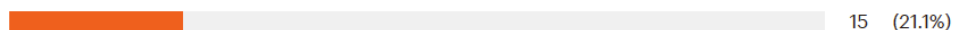
Question 4 has 71 answers (Radio Buttons)

“4) I attend Sunday service at Unity of Bellevue...”

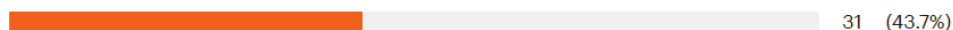
Online exclusively.



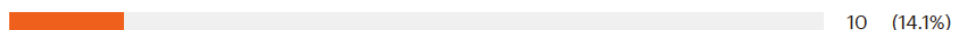
In person exclusively.



A mix of online and in person.



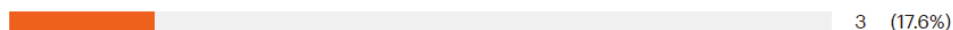
I have not attended Unity of Bellevue, either online or in person, since building re-opening in December 2021.



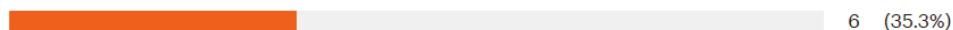
Question 5 has 17 answers (Radio Buttons)

“5) Answer this question ONLY if you answered, “I attend online exclusively” (question 4a). I attend online exclusively because...”

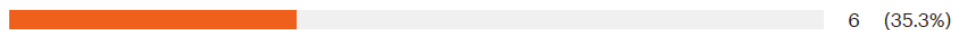
I'm not vaccinated so can't attend due to UOB policy.



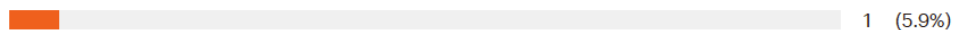
I avoid going out in public in general due to potential COVID-19 exposure.



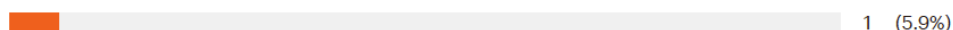
It's simply more convenient.



I can only attend online, because I don't drive, I live too far away, etc.

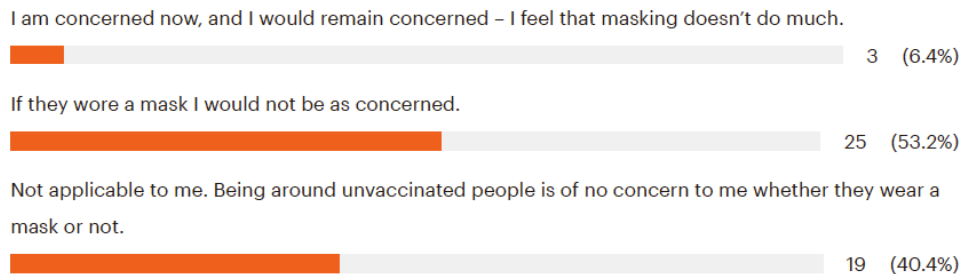


I like online services better.



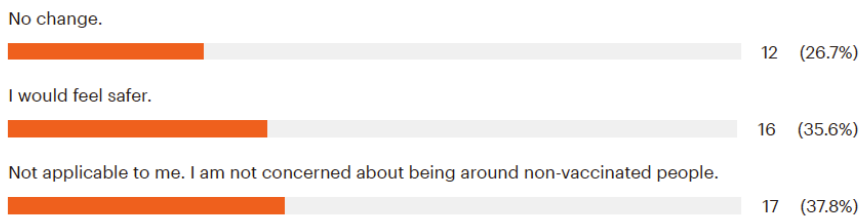
Question 6 has 47 answers (Radio Buttons)

Question 7 has 45 answers (Radio Buttons)

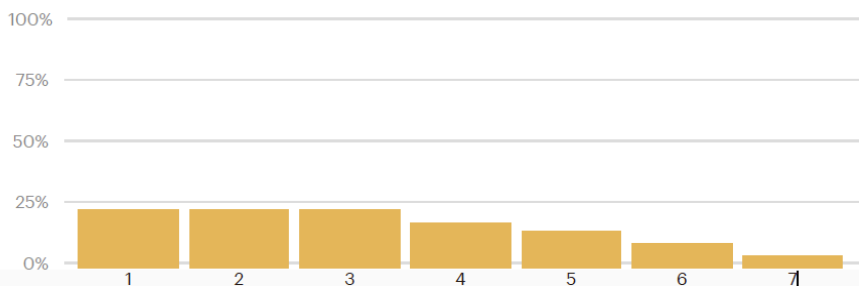
